

We also offer free printing, scanning, and copying for the required documents for the application.

SELECTION PROCESS:

After the submission deadline, the EHIP selection committee meets to review applications. The properties that are deemed critical and/or under by-law compliance orders will be prioritized. Once the selection process is complete, selection packages will be sent by mail. Those selected will receive instructions to communicate to the Community Housing Liaison that they will be accepting or withdrawing from the program.
