


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Application Drop-In Session: Thursday, April 18th, 2024 from 12 to 2pm at 509 Selkirk Ave

This is an opportunity in collaboration with the CRA outreach team to discuss any questions you may have and retrieve your <u>Notice of Assessment</u>. Please bring a piece of identification and any documents you have on hand such as property tax bill, income documents, and any compliance orders (if applicable). We also offer free printing, scanning, and copying for the required documents for the application.

SELECTION PROCESS:

After the submission deadline, the EHIP selection committee meets to review applications. The properties that are deemed critical and/or under by-law compliance orders will be prioritized. Once the selection process is complete, selection packages will be sent by mail. Those selected will receive instructions to communicate to the Community Housing Liaison that they will be accepting or withdrawing from the program.
