Citizens' Bridge is a pre-employment program that supports low-income individuals (1) obtain and/or securely store **identification** such as Canadian birth certificates, (2) provides referrals to open a **bank account** with Assiniboine Credit Union, and (3) is the home of the **Road To Your Learners** and **Ready To Drive** programs that provide classroom and in-car lessons in support of obtaining a **drivers licence**

All of which help to improve an individuals qualifications when entering the workforce



Storefront Enhancement Grant (SEG) is a cost-shared grant eligible for North End businesses and organizations for exterior frontage renovations

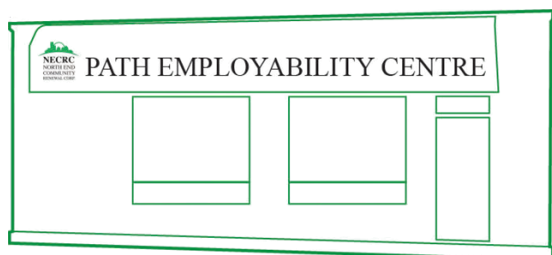


EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

PATH Employability Centre

PATH Employability Centre is a community drop-in program that provides career counselling and a range of resources helping individuals overcome barriers to employment

PATH2SUCCESS is a 4-week employment readiness program offering assistance in cover letter and resume building, interview skills, training, introduction to entry-level jobs, and more



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

NECRC has hosted the free annual Picnic in the Park event in celebration of the North End for over 20 years in St. John's Park!

NERI Small Grant Fund is an annual grant available to community groups administering programming in core North End neighbourhoods

The Recreation and Leisure Grant is a year-round grant available to community groups in support of a recreation or leisure initiative



The Selkirk Avenue Farmers' Market is held every year at the Bell Tower where you can shop local vendors and utilize a pay-what-you-can produce stand

The Good Food Box program offers a subsidized fresh produce and grocery box for \$20 valued for over \$40



HOUSING PROGRAMS

The Tenant Landlord Cooperation (TLC) is an eviction prevention program that helps individuals understand their rental rights and responsibilities and can assist in upholding them

The Exterior Home Improvement Program (EHIP) is an annual grant available to homeowners and landlords in North End home improvement zones to support exterior projects affecting safety, utility costs, and overall beautification

Energy Efficiency Manitoba partners with NECRC to work with pre-approved North End homeowners for energy efficient upgrades such as insulation or a new furnace

Building Construction Mentorship Program (BCMP) is an apprenticeship program for residents interested in carpentry and housing construction
