The BCMP is a well establish, transformative training initiative that provides participants with meaningful opportunities to develop career pathways in the construction trades. We're looking for a Team Lead to spearhead the growth of this program and guide its strategic expansion.

This position offers a structured growth path that mirrors the program's expansion - you'll start with a focused 20-hour work week and incrementally grow to full-time employment as we scale our operations and impact. Beginning with hands-on involvement with trainees and site visits, then evolving into higher-level program management as we build our team and expand our reach.

Position Growth Timeline:

- Q1: 20 hours/week Program foundation and direct trainee support
- **Q2-Q3:** 30 hours/week Expanded management as team grows
- Q4: 40 hours/week Full program leadership and strategic oversight

As the Team Lead you would:

- Be responsible for implementing our redesigned program structure, conducting trainee interviews, coordinating placements, and monitoring progress through site visits and supervisor communication.
- Develop policies, manage budgets, prepare bi-monthly reports, and utilize digital information systems.
- Negotiate with training partners to strengthen existing agreements, build new relationships with government, industry employers and educational institutions, create mentorship networks with skilled tradespeople, and represent BCMP at community events.
- Supervise staff, lead hiring processes, conduct performance reviews, ensure safety compliance, and foster a positive culture focused on participant success.
- Work collaboratively with other NECRC departments to implement communication strategies and showcase program successes through various media platforms.

- Bachelor's degree in business, social work, community development, or related field (or equivalent experience)
- Minimum 3 years of management experience
- Proven track record in partnership development and management
- Construction or related field experience
- Familiarity with WHMIS and safety protocols
- Strong understanding of employment barriers
- Excellent communication and negotiation skills
- Proficiency with MS Office and database management
- Valid driver's license and vehicle access
